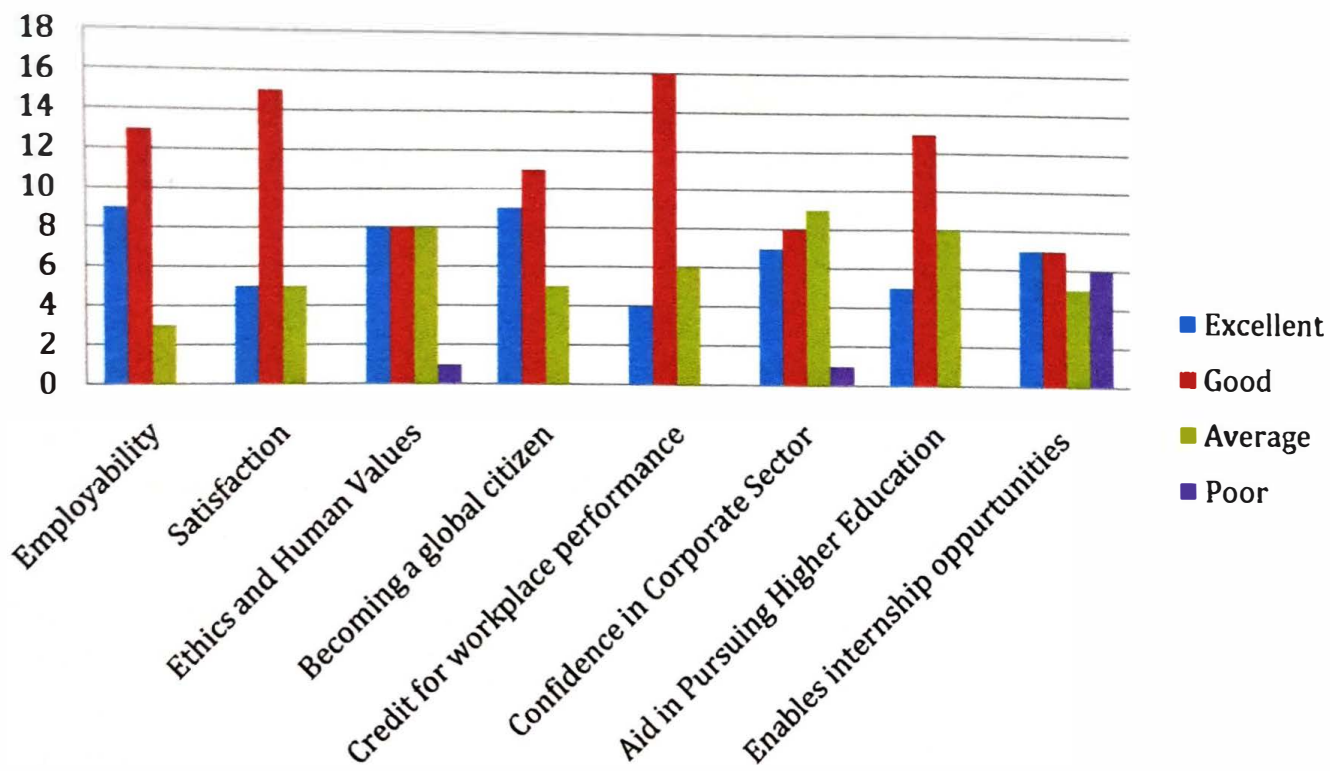

- Enabling internship opportunities as well as ethical and human values aspect and the preparation to have confidence in the corporate sector have been rated as possible areas of improvement.

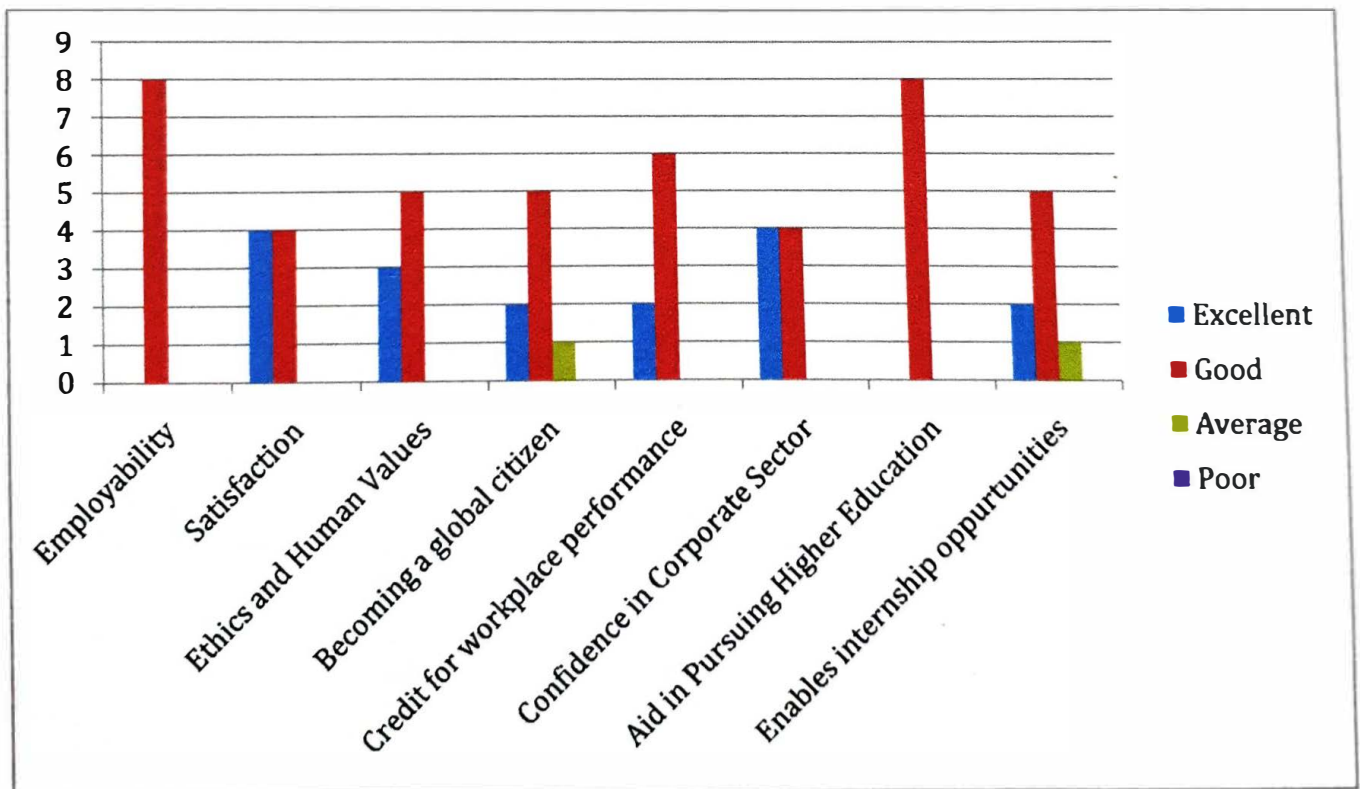
