Action Taken Report on the Feedback Analysis of the Syllabus by Students, Teachers, Employers & Alumni, AY: 2023-2024:

To maintain the quality and teaching - learning activities of the prescribed syllabi the college has collected feedback from various stakeholders viz. Students, Teachers, Employers and Alumni. In this regard as usual this academic year (2023-24) also feedback has been collected from all the stakeholders as pointed above and the following actions have been taken:

The analysis of Teachers' Feedback on Syllabus clearly shows that the syllabus is well organized and easy to follow. Precisely second preference of the faculty members find the syllabus enhances the faculty members ability to design quizzes/tests/assignments/examinations and projects to evaluate students effectively. Third preference of them are satisfied with the learning objectives are clear and approximate to the needs of students. Fourth preference regarding the syllabus is designed according to students learning ability. Fifth preference is given to the current syllabus helps students to get internship/ project work.

Action taken for the above analysis: After analysing the above analysis of the teachers, some teachers suggested for industrial visits and field visits which are relevant to corporate sector/MNCs. As per the suggestion given by the faculty members the National Seminar on Dr.Shivarama Karanth and his works was organized in association with Kannada Development Authority, Govt. of Karnataka. So also Management activities for BBA students were also conducted.

Action taken for the above analysis: While taking into account of the feedback of the alumni the college arranged placement training wherein the topics such as communication skills, aptitude, grooming, interview techniques were imparted. Along with the above, industrial visits also were arranged as per the alumni feedback.
