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

#### Teachers' Feedback

The analysis of Teachers' Feedback on Syllabus clearly shows that the syllabus is well organized and easy to follow. Precisely 98% of the faculty members find it well organized and caters to the needs of students' learning ability. 86 percentage of the teaching fraternity comments that the learning objectives are clear and approximate to the needs of the students. 76% of them are satisfied with the quality of the existing syllabus. But, the feedback also addresses the failure of the syllabus' quality in imparting additional knowledge and employability enhancement.

## **Action Taken Report on the Feedback on Syllabus** by Students, Teachers, Employers & Alumni, AY- 2022-2023

To maintain the quality and teaching - learning activities of the prescribed syllabi the college has collected feedback from various stakeholders viz. Students, Teachers, Employers and Alumni. In this regard as usual this academic year (2022-23) also feedback has been collected from all the stakeholders as pointed above and the following actions have been taken:

1. The analysis of Students' Feedback on Syllabus displays that 90% of the students are satisfied with the sequencing and the order of the units in the syllabus. Among the students who submitted the feedback, 78% of them find it job oriented and 68% opine that it matches with the requirements of the industry. 68% percentage of students states that the objectives are appropriate and relevant to the syllabus. The aptness of the quality and the quantity of the syllabus is above average (66%).

Action taken for the above analysis: After evaluating the above analysis, a few students opined that they need more exposure like field visits, Industrial visits. So, the college had arranged more field visits and Industrial visits.

Among the Employers who submitted the feedback, 44% of them find it the contents of the syllabus are job oriented and 44% opined that it matches with the requirements of the industry. 44% percentage of employers' states that the syllabus has been revised timely by the University. The aptness of the syllabus can be covered on time (44%).

Action taken for the above analysis: As per the employers' feedback more industrial visits were arranged. So that the students can interact with the higher ups and would learn the nitty gritty of the industries. Through the industrial visits and placement training, students also got equipped with industrial requirements.
