

1. Additional 20% intake of the students is permitted than the sanctioned intake for the Academic Year 2021-22 limited to the present course/combination by the Government Order.
2. Provision is made for BA and B.Sc students of first year (1st and 2nd Semesters) to choose subjects instead of combination as per NEP 2020. Accordingly students' intake has been permitted as per the sanctioned combination in the individual subjects. As far as possible, college should maintain the subject wise admission for the current year.
3. Care should be taken not to exceed 50% of the total intake for the open electives.
4. The said affiliation order is subject to conditions brought out by the government/ university from time to time.

Special note: 2020-21 academic year's LIC committee's report is enclosed here- with, affiliation and student intake is renewed as per the university norms. The college should send compliance report as per the short coming mentioned in the LIC report within 15 days. Failing to comply with the application for the renewal of affiliation for the academic year 2021-22, will not be accepted.

Conditions:

1. Should adhere to the conditions of the LIC report.
2. Additional admission other than sanctioned intake will not be approved by the university.
3. Additional section to any course should not be created without the prior permission from the university.
4. Roster system should be followed relating to UG students' admission as stipulated by the govt from time to time
5. Students, teaching and non teaching staff members should comply with the orders and notifications issued by the university from time to time. Admissions should be made as per the eligibility conditions laid down by the university at the time of sanctioning affiliation to the college.

6. For P.G. Courses, regarding admission and fees to be collected by the institution as per the admission norms of the university from time to time and the ratio is 50% (for government colleges 100%) sponsored by the govt.
7. Sexual harassment of girls/women employees in the institution, is a punishable offence as per the Supreme Court judgment dated 13th August, 1997 in the case of Vyshaka v/s Rajasthan state govt. Anyone who indulges in this kind of activity can be terminated from the service / in case of students, admission can be cancelled. To control such kind of activities a 'Redressed Cell' should be established in the college as per S.C guidelines.
8. Principal/ Management should take institution in achieving the academic progress of the students & measures should be taken to improve the quality of the courses. Both students and the serving staff should be treated with much consideration.
9. The college should not retain the marks cards or any other document beyond six months. The documents should be returned to the students concerned after the admission approval process. The same should be intimated to the university.
10. If a candidate has applied for T.C; the college should issue the same without any hassle. Regarding the tuition fee of the year/semester except the tuition fee, other additional fee should not be collected as per the rules.
11. The college should not collect capitation fee in any form.
12. Kannada should be used in administration.
13. The college should apply for renewal of affiliation for the academic year 2022-23.
14. The colleges which complete five academic years of existence should immediately go for NAAC accreditation.
15. The principal should send the eligible teachers' list for evaluation to the BOE chairpersons concerned. The eligible teachers should compulsorily report for evaluation work; failing which the college affiliation will be cancelled.
16. Make sure from the university before giving admission to the affiliated subjects/combination to the students.
17. GST is applicable to affiliation fee from Academic Year 2018-19 to 2021-22, so pay the GST @ 18% calculating for all the four years.





