**Date-04-02-2021**

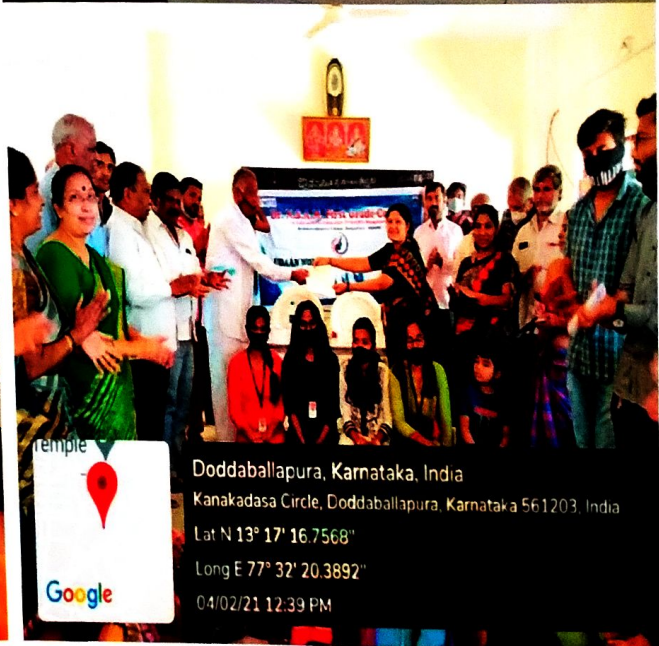

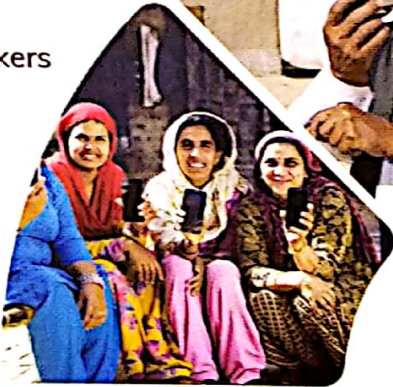

Report on "Data collection survey on school dropouts during Covid-19"  
On the request by Gram Panchayat , Singanayakanahalli , Bangalore to Dr.N.S.A.M  
First Grade College to assist them for door to door survey to collect data on school  
drop outs during lock down period of Covid-19.

Community Orientation Club- Sahabalve of Dr.N.S.A.M First Grade College under  
the supervision of Dr.R.Shanti Iyer and by the guidance of Dr.M.S.Annapurna  
Kishore ,a team of 15 students from third semester B.Com and BBA stream  
conducted this survey.

The survey is carried out with the mobile app "Karnataka H2H children survey" app  
developed by the Centre for e-Governance, Government of Karnataka. The students  
got orientation for this exercise by Gram Panchayat Development Officer  
Mr.Damodar and team. Dr.M.S.Annapurna Kishore , Coordinator , Research  
Development Cell-Anweshana of Dr.N.S.A.M FGC conducted an orientation to  
students on how to collect primary data for the survey. Our students did this survey  
work for three (03) days. Started on 9/2/2021, 23/2/2021 and 24/2/2021. Due to  
preparatory exams from 10/2/2021 to 21/2/2021 students took break, resumed the  
survey work on 23/2/2021.

A team of 15 students carried out this work in four (04) villages namely  
Myalappanahalli, Madappanahalli, Avalahalli and Singanayakanahalli of  
Singanayakanahalli Gram Panchayat area. The door to door survey with the help of  
mobile app conducted to collect data of children aged between 6-14 years. Once the  
ration card data is fed on mobile app it gives complete details of the family members  
and it is easy to find the school dropout. Approximately 400 houses have been  
surveyed, only the houses considered in survey are those which has the children of  
the age group in between 6 -14 years. During the lockdown, in rural areas, children  
go for work to support their family.

Learning outcome: Students exposed to the reality of harsh life due to Corona in  
rural places, especially, social and economic life. They learnt the communication  
skill during this survey. Students created awareness of importance of education  
among parents in the villages.

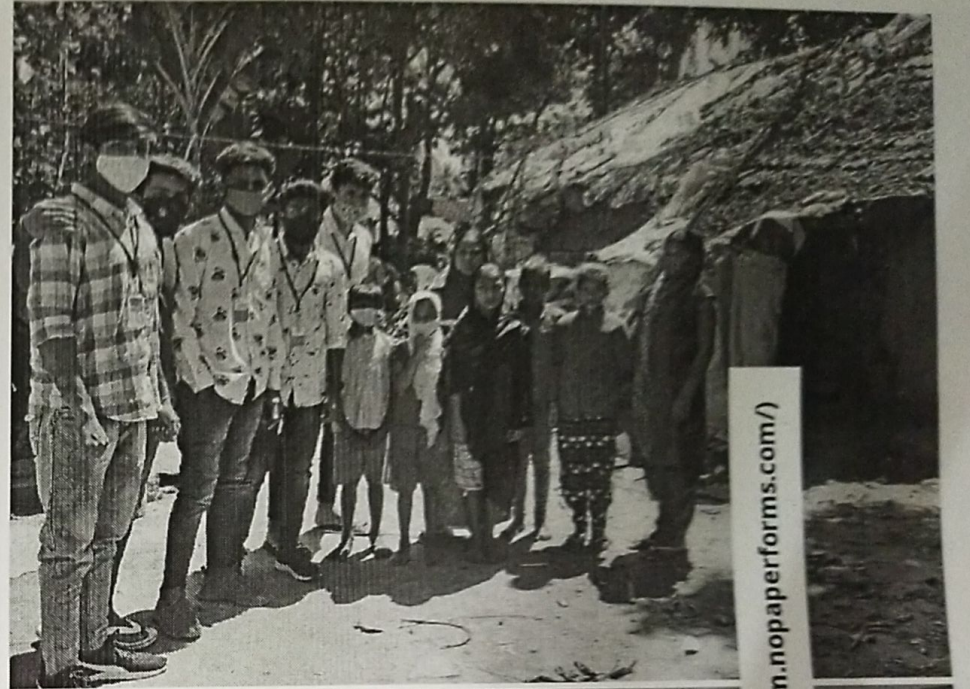

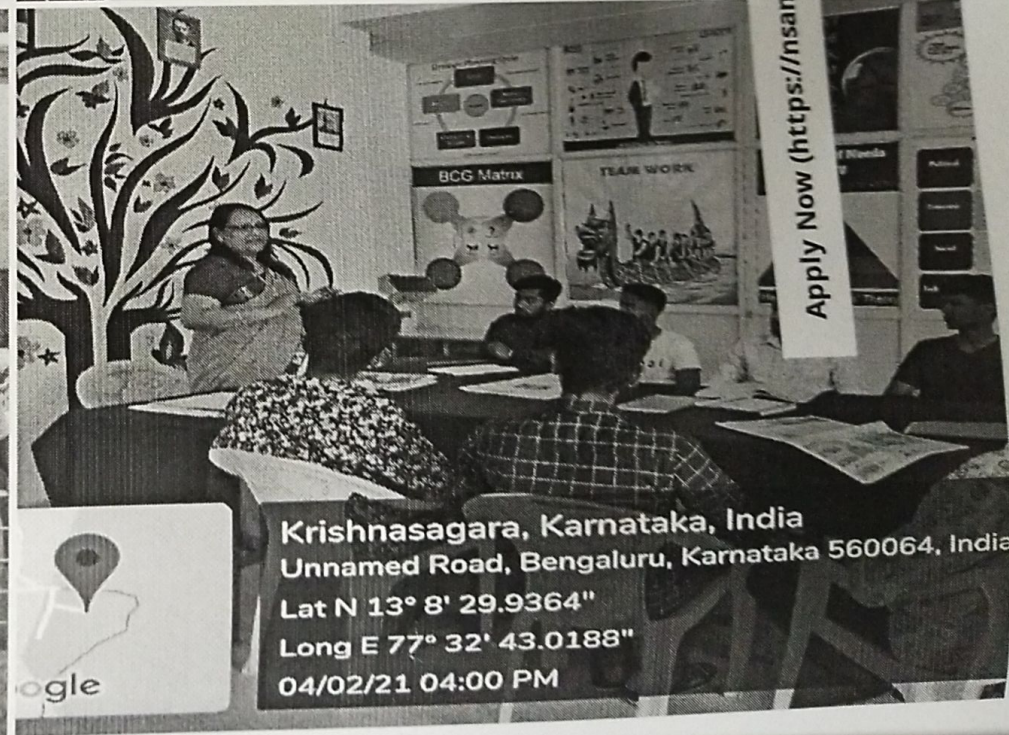

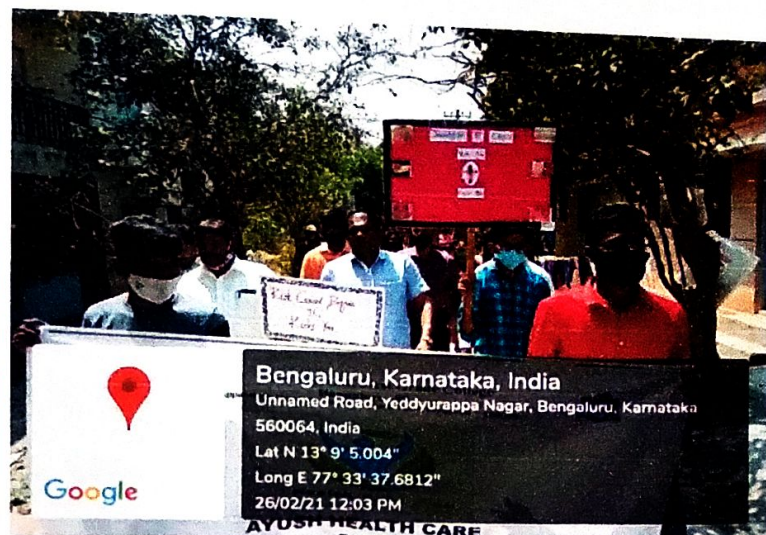
