2. Policy and Framework Implementation

- Establish an anonymous feedback mechanism to encourage reporting of genderrelated issues without fear or hesitation.
- Set up an Internal Committee dedicated to addressing and resolving grievances related to gender concerns.

3. Facilities for Students and Staff Members

To ensure a supportive and safe environment, the following facilities will be enhanced and maintained:

- Medical Room for immediate health support.
- Common Room for Girls as a private and relaxing space.
- Manual Pad Vending Machine and Sanitary Napkin Incinerator Machine to promote menstrual hygiene.
- CCTV Surveillance in campus and hostel areas to enhance safety.
- Counselling Room for mental health and gender-related counselling services accessible to both girls and boys.
- Separate Washrooms for boys and girls with grooming facilities, including mirrors and proper hygiene arrangements.

By implementing this action plan, the institution seeks to create a campus culture where gender equity is understood, respected, and practiced by all.
